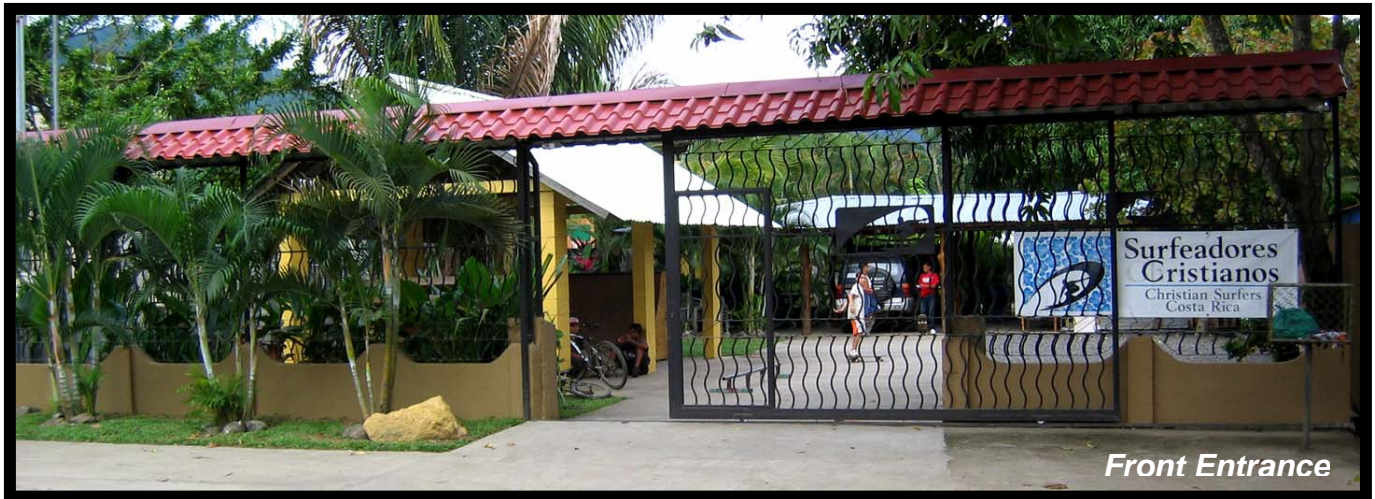

**Final Property Payment
& Expansion of Property Usage**



Executive Summary

Christian Surfers Costa Rica (CSCR) national headquarters is being established and developed in Jaco, Costa Rica. Jaco, a major coastal community of Costa Rica approximately two hours from the capitol, San Jose, and midway along the Pacific coastline makes it an excellent location for the CSCR headquarters.

Based on the idea that surfers are the best people to reach other surfers, CSCR established a chapter in Jaco as the first step. With an eye towards the future, CSCR began the purchase of a piece of property and some development on that property as the next step in our strategy to fulfilling our Vision/Mission. Next, CSCR will develop the property as the national headquarters for starting other chapters in surfing communities along the Costa Rican coastline by providing direction, training, and support specifically tailored to Costa Rica. In addition, the facilities will also support the local chapter in Jaco. CSCR will serve nationals and missionaries who have a vision to reach out to surfers with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

At the same time, CSCR chapters will also seek to have a positive impact in the lives of those around us by providing a safe place to “hang out”, modeling and teaching a positive lifestyle, support of local programs and ministries, and helping to steer people away from drugs, alcohol and the sex industry through chapter involvement in the local communities and the relationships that are established with the people.

Currently there are existing efforts to establish chapters in Tamarindo, Nosara, and Dominical.



Our Vision and Mission:

Vision: To be a Christian presence and witness to the Costa Rican surfing community.

Mission: To reach surfers with the Gospel of Jesus Christ, connect them to local churches so that they can then go back into their communities and beyond to reach other surfers.

Our Strategy:

Our strategy is based on starting local chapters throughout Costa Rican surf communities and establishing a national headquarters to train and support local chapters and missionaries.

We believe the way to accomplish this is to train and mobilize Costa Rican surfers and surfer missionaries with a heart for reaching the Costa Rican surf communities. We will accomplish this by:

- Over the next year, solidifying the Christian Surfers Jaco chapter as a model and training chapter and continue to develop the national headquarters and training/support facility
- Mobilize and train leaders and missionaries to start new and solidify emerging chapters
- Prepare missionaries entering the Costa Rican surf culture
- Guide and direct mission teams to local chapters throughout Costa Rica for outreach and development
- Host various conferences and seminars for training, encouragement, and support
- Discipleship training
- Local chapter meetings and events
- Host and/or support various surf contest throughout Costa Rica



1. About Us

2. Location

We are based in Playa Jaco, the largest beach town in Costa Rica.

There is a large community of local and international surfers, along with all the surf culture trappings that go along with surfers. It is also the jumping off point for many traveling surfers due to its proximity along the Pacific Coast.

And because of the recent growth, you can find most of what you'd need for your surf time in Costa Rica.



Jaco is also a booming town for tourism, located about 2 hours from the capital of Costa Rica - San Jose. Jaco is growing at a tremendous pace with many condominium and hotel projects in process and in the works, shopping centers, grocery stores, restaurants and of course, surf shops. Jaco has become a center for beach living along the central Pacific coast.

3. Opportunity

The composition of Christ's church around the world is quite different today than it was just fifty years ago. Today nearly two-thirds of the evangelical church is non-western. Largely as a result of western missions the world has seen tremendous growth of Christianity in places like Asia, Africa and Latin America. A key to reaching the world for Christ and seeing it transformed by His power has now become the mobilization of believers from the non-western world.

Now is the time to invest in the next generation of leaders in Latin America and prepare them for ministry in their own communities and beyond.

4. Current Challenges

Part 1: Final Property Mortgage Payment

To fulfill our strategy of establishing a national headquarters, CSCR began to invest into a piece of property in the city of Jaco located on one of the main streets in 2003. It is near the beach and the main coastal highway. Our first step in fulfilling our strategy with regards to the property is to complete the mortgage payment for the property. The people who sold us the property have carried a loan allowing us to make monthly payments for the last 4 years. They no longer desire to do so. This year we need to pay off the rest of the mortgage and complete the purchase of the property by November 29, 2007.

Challenge: We need \$71,000 to pay the mortgage on the property. The mortgage payment is due at the end of August and we need receipt of monies by November 1, 2007 to facilitate the payment. See the end of the proposal for ways to support this challenge.

Part 2: Expansion of Property Usage

Currently the property is the base of operations for the beginning stages of CSCR and it also provides a location for the CS Jaco chapter to minister through. To progress in our goals, the property will need to be developed specifically for use as a national headquarters and training facility. The property and its facilities will be used to:

- Base of operations for the CSCR national ministry
- Mobilize and train leaders and missionaries to start new and develop existing chapters
- Prepare missionaries entering the Costa Rican surf culture
- Guide and direct mission teams to local chapters throughout Costa Rica for outreach and development
- Host various conferences and seminars for training, encouragement, and support
- Discipleship training
- Local chapter meetings and events

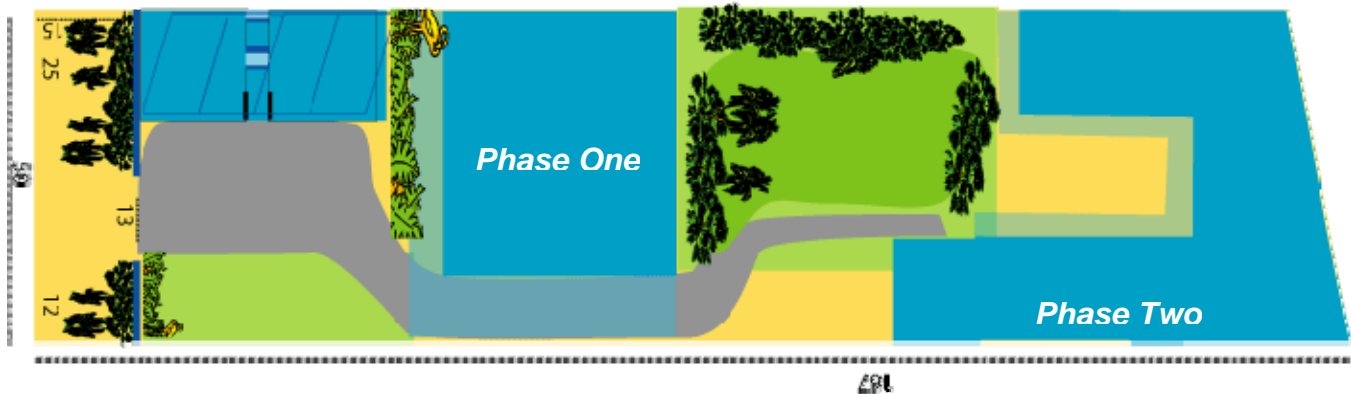


Challenge:

For Phase One - A facility is needed that can accommodate large meetings, training areas, temporary office space and some temporary housing to replace what is currently on the property that will be rebuilt to proper standards and specific usage. It will be a two story building that will continue to be utilized by the local ministry and be a transition phase as we continue with the project. The cost estimate for this phase is \$60,750.

For Phase Two – This phase is still in the planning stage at this time. It will use the back half of the property and be a mixture of housing, office, training rooms, restroom facilities, kitchen, etc. As we finalize payment for the property and begin Phase One, Phase Two will be introduced through an updated proposal.

Planned layout of the property. Formal plans and drawings will be forthcoming.



5. Conclusion
